Dear Sister Muir:



Then you mention that "there is grave concern over certain areas of practice against which the Assemblies of God Fellowship, as a national body, is taking a stand". Our feeling is this, that if we are doing things that are causing grave and sincere concern, and desire to be open and talk with you about them, isn't a meeting very necessary and important?
