

The June Official Board meeting was held Tuesday, the 28th, at the church. Present: Pastor and Mrs. Bogdan; Brothers Bugieda, Davis, Gerhart, Nendel, Sakash, Schlack, Yee; Sisters Sakash and Muir (11).

Pastor Bogdan read from Hebrews 12:1-15, followed by prayer by the individual members of the Board.

The minutes of the Church Clerk were approved as prepared.

The report of the Treasurer was approved as prepared.

Old Business

Insurance for the totaled church van has been settled upon and we are awaiting the check for approximately \$2500.

After discussion concerning the need for a van, motion was made (Davis, Bugieda) that a van be rented for the period of two weeks that the VVBS is in session. Motion carried. It was also decided that Brother Yee will look into the cost of leasing a van for a long term, etc.

New Business

Brother Albert Davis has been invited to attend the International Conference of Itinerant Evangelists (Billy Graham) in Amsterdam as a steward, from July 4th to the 24th. Brother Davis stated that there would be A/G nationals there in need of equipment. After discussion, it was moved (Nendel, Yee) that Brother Davis share this need with the congregation on July 3rd, at which time an offering will be taken. A minimum of \$200 will be given to Brother Davis, and total offering over, to be given to a designated or determined Assembly of God national attending the ICIE. Motion carried.

Brother Raymond L. Gannon has requested an offering of \$250 to help in the repair of facilities of Messiah Mission. Motion was made to this effect - check will go to Rev. Paul Kyllonen of Northeast Assembly of God, Home Missions Treasurer, Southeast Section. Motion carried.

July 3rd will be celebrated in Highway as Military Day, with special mention being given to those from the military attending our services. The Board designated \$50 to be given to the Military Department in Springfield.

The General Council has also requested that a special offering be taken on July 31st for the General Council to convene in California in August.
