

The Official Board met in the Pastor's Study Sunday, July 15th ('84) at 5 P.M. for a combined June and July meeting. (The June meeting was postponed because of the funeral service for Leon Grzybowski).

Present: Pastor and Mrs. Bogdan; Brothers Cook, Davis, Fearn, Lauf, Nendel, Picazio, Schlack and Yee; Sisters Bullwinkle, Cooper and Muir (13)

Pastor Bogdan read the third chapter of II Peter; this was followed by prayer by the individual members of the Board.

The minutes of the Church Clerk were accepted with an addition - the California Highschoolers (from Whittier) were furnished a meal on Friday, July 6th, by Bro. Phil Menditto - Highway furnished drinks and dessert and after the service, snack and dessert.

The Treasurer's report was accepted as prepared.

A letter was read from the Pennsylvania-Delaware District concerning a contribution to the new camping grounds and conference center in Carlisle. It was suggested that we ask someone from headquarters to come to Highway and give further details on the situation.

Brother Jim Heurich will be soliciting funds and pledges for Teen Challenge. On October 20th Teen Challenge will have a Radiothon, trying to raise \$20,000. Those contributing \$200 will have their names mentioned on the Radiothon. Pastor Bogdan requested that the Board channel their contributions through the church.

The Servicemen's Department in Springfield is asking for an offering. We have eight young men in the services, receiving material from this department, etc. It was agreed that we would send \$50 as an offering.

Brother Les Lauf will take the position vacated by Leon Grzybowski; he will be titled Plant Superintendent. Anastazia Grzybowski will continue her part-time help - two days per week.

Brother Davis gave a report on the repairs to the building. The Edward R. Sabin Company has done a fine job on the boilers and the installation of ceiling fans in the main sanctuary. A maintenance contract with Sabin Company will probably be accepted. Most of the work on the roof is finished - there are a few more repairs to be taken care of.

After discussion it was decided to give Anastazia and her daughters the sum of \$2000 in honor of the service of her husband, Leon, who served the church faithfully for thirty years.

The meeting then adjourned.
