Brother Overstreet voluntarily acted as spokesman and informed the Board that the meeting had been called to advise the Official Board the physical condition of our Pastor, Rev. Wesley R. Steelberg.

After some little discussion Brother Earl Wilson moved that there be appointed from the Board of Elders a temporary chairman of the meeting. This motion was seconded by Brother Spain, and carried.

Brother Spain nominated Brother Overstreet as temporary chairman. Brother Bell moved that the nominations be closed. Brother Overstreet was elected temporary chairman of the meeting.

Further discussion was had with reference to the physical condition of the Pastor and the conduct of the Boards in caring for the work in the Pastor's absence.

It was suggested by Brother Overstreet that all discussions had thus far be stricken from the record.

Moved by Brother Spain, seconded by Brother Hepworth, and carried, that the Board of Elders wait on the Pastor and inform him that it is the unanimous desire of the Official Board that he take a real rest, that the Board is back of him, praying for him and getting under the burden in his absence.

Moved by Brother Hollahan, seconded by Brother Spain, and carried, that the Elders inform the Pastor that he is not to attend the funeral of Sister Billman on Tuesday, January 24th, as they do not feel such a step would be wise.

After some discussion with reference to closing the balconies, the meeting, on motion, adjourned with prayer.
