The meeting was opened with prayer.

The Pastor stated that the meeting had been called as a result of his requesting Brother Hollahan to make arrangements with Brother and Sister Herbert McKittrick for a meeting with the Board of Elders, and the Pastor, regarding the decision of the Board concerning the Shirers' return, whereupon Brother and Sister McKittrick requested to meet with the Official Board.

After some discussion and certain statements being made, it was felt that lest the Shirers would be disappointed at the decision of the Official Board in asking them to remain on the field another year, as there had been no correspondence with them explaining the matter, that a vote of confidence be sent to them, whereupon it was moved by Brother Fred Hepworth, seconded by Brother Fearn, and carried :

"That we send to the Shirers a letter of regrets that they could not come home at this time; that the Board voted on the question of their return on the recommendation of Springfield; that the Board is back of them one hundred per cent, and that we hope they will be able to come home soon."

(This letter, authorized by the Official Board, was drawn up, submitted to the Board and approved, sent air mail to the Shirers, a copy of which is attached hereto).

On motion of Brother Fred Hepworth, the meeting adjourned, with prayer.
