The Pastor read a letter from Brother Lloyd Shirer, addressed to the Official Board, dated October 21, 1942, advising the Board of the result of their meeting with the Officials at Springfield; and he also read excerpts from letters received by the Pastor from Brother Perkin, one of which was dated September 11, 1942.

After some discussion with reference to the extra \$1,000 for the fares for Shirens' return from Africa, it was moved by Brother Combs that the Trustee Board meet with Brother and Sister Shirer, go over the matter with them and make everything satisfactory to them. This motion was seconded by Brother Fearn and duly carried.

The Pastor also read letter dated November 16, 1942, from Brother Perkin with reference to Sister Louise Hackert's return, and the cost, which would approximate between \$800.00 and \$1,000.

The Pastor conferred with the Board as to their desire with reference to continuing with the radio program after his departure, stating that he had a very good contact with the Station, that he carried on from week to week, and that there had been times when he did not have sufficient to meet the need, and it was allowed to be taken care of during the following week, and he desired to let the Church have the benefit of this connection if they so choose.

It was the consensus of the Board that the Church would continue with the radio program at least until a new Pastor was elected, and then the matter could be taken up with him.

The meeting adjourned, with prayer.
