A meeting of the Official Board was called by the Pastor immediately after the Sunday morning service on November 29, 1944.

Brother Bragg said the meeting had been called with reference to the Missionary Program, the list of names having been submitted not being correct, and that Brother and Sister McClay would like to have an understanding with the Board with reference to Missionary requirements, and asked Brother McClay to make a statement to the Board.

Brother McClay brought before the Board the fact that if a Missionary in India is handicapped with only just sufficient support for himself, and also the fact that living costs have advanced greatly, the cost for a native worker is about three times as much as it was; that on returning to the field he would like a staff of workers, say 6 or 8; a tent that would seat 1,000 people, and an addressograph; that some Missionaries now returning are receiving \$60.00 plus operating expenses.

These matters were discussed with a view to an understanding of what the Missionary really needs and some suggestions were made.

Brother Hollahan moved that the Church support Brother and Sister McClay in India on the basis of \$60.00 per month, or that which is approved by Springfield, plus the support of one native worker at \$20.00, and \$25.00 a month for station expenses. This motion was duly seconded and unanimously carried.

Brother Frank Simokat moved that the Church send Brother and Sister George Waggoner \$100.00 as a gift, to take care of what they have paid out in entertaining and taking care of soldiers and service men, and that their salary be increased to \$60.00 a month. This motion was duly seconded and carried.

On motion of Brother Hollahan, duly seconded by Brother Griffith, the following Missionary Program was unanimously adopted:

Brother and Sister George Waggoner, India, \$60. a month, \$360.00 2 children 96.00
