Meeting held at the church on Tuesday evening, July 1, 1947.

Meeting opened with prayer.

The Pastor stated there were several things that should be discussed and action taken thereon before the summer vacation, the main one being the continuance of the radio program, in view of the financial condition of the Church.

Bro. Elmer Day gave a brief statement as to the financial condition, showing that the General Fund is in the red. He also stated that the oil unit to be installed would cost approximately \$1,125, which should be done before the Fall.

The Pastor also brought up the question of out-station work, stating that Sister Allen had a work at 1133 N. Howard Street, having a five year lease, three years of which has already run, at \$12.00 a month, and she would like Highway to take over the work there. The room seats about 50 people, contains a piano and altar. It was suggested that this might be a good opportunity to help those who are home from Bible School, and when they have graduated from School.

There was discussion pro and con on both questions.

Brother Krause made a motion that the Broadcast be discontinued, seconded by Bro. F. Hepworth, and carried.

Brother F. Hepworth made a motion that the Pastor and Board of Elders supervise the opening up and carrying on of the new out-station work. This motion was seconded by F. Simokat.

Bro. T. Griffith moved to amend the previous motion by the inclusion of a member from each Board. Motion seconded by Bro. Hollahan, and carried (8 to 7)

The above motion, including the amendment, was put to a vote and carried.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
