Ball had made the statement that if the two missionaries Springfield had in mind for us to take on and support were not ready, that he could find two that were ready to go to South America. From contact with Springfield, or the Missions Department, it was ascertained that it was their desire that Highway take on the two nurses that had been previously referred to them. Consequently he thought it order that we discuss the advisability of Highway backing the two nurses, Sisters Betty June Shakleton and Hilda Eichen, who were preparing to go to the Gold Coast as Missionary Nurses.

It was stated that the cost would be approximately the same as that previously paid the Shirers.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, Sisters Betty June Shackleton and Hilda Eichen were taken on as Highway Missionary Nurses for the Gold Coast.

A motion was made, seconded and carried, that an investigation be made with reference to the suggestion by Brother Ball at the Thanksgiving Convention for a missionary to the Latin American Field, and also as to the desire of our own members who have gone to Bible School who might have calls for the mission field.

There being no further business, the meeting
