Brother Griffith stated that the meeting had been called to discuss a name for the new corporation for the Elderly Folk's Home, and that several names had been suggested, one of which was Highway Memorial Elderly Folk's Home.

After some discussion, on motion duly seconded and carried, the suggested name "Assembly of God Home", was passed, with the instructions to first contact Brother Newton Chase as to whether the Assemblies would rather that name not be used.

A further motion was made, duly seconded and carried, that the name "Highway Home For The Aged" be adopted in the event that the first name could not be used for any reason.

(Efforts were made to contact Brother Newton Chase, without success, and as it was desired to submit the name to the attorney for submission to Harrisburg promptly, the last suggested name, "Highway Home For The Aged," was used.)
