Krause, seconded by Brother \_\_\_\_\_ and after some questions and consideration, the decision of the Board was to accept Mr. and Mrs. Brock as our missionaries, and that it would be well if they could visit Highway on their itinergry work rather than bring them a long distance, if possible.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned with prayer.
