

Meeting of the Official Board of Highway Mission Tabernacle called pursuant to notice, held at the Church on Tuesday, July 15, 1952, 8 P.M.

Present: Bro. Charles Krause, Bogdan, Elmer Day, T. Griffith, Walter McAnney, Dursey, J. Lanham, Emma Zehner, M. Nethery, M. Griffin and C.M. Payne.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Bro. Lanham.

Bro. Krause assumed the chair.

Bro. Krause read a letter from the Assistant Superintendent of the Apalachain, Mr. A. H. Morrison, in answer to one directed to Him from the Board, relating to the work at Mendota, Virginia, where Sister Minnie Baehr is presently located, in which he definitely stated he did not advise putting any more money in the work there.

Bro. Krause also read excerpts from other letters received from Sister Baehr. He stated that Bro. Lafferty had phoned and said he could not attend the meeting, but said he would like to suggest that three people make a visit to see Sister Baehr with the idea of persuading her to go into the Home.

After some discussion, on motion of Brother Dursey, seconded by Bro. Griffith, and carried, it was

RESOLVED that a letter be written to Sister Baehr explaining the careful consideration of the Board from various angles of this whole matter; that it does not feel there is enough activity in the work there to give further financial aid, and advise her to accept admission into the Home at Pinelas Park where she has been accepted, as her age for further labors being against her.

Bro. Griffith suggested that Bro. Krause, Bro. Day and Sister Payne get together and draft the letter, and call the Board together for its approval.

On motion the meeting adjourned with prayer by Bro. Day.
