

REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON IMPROVEMENTS

Submitted Wednesday Evening, May 7, 1924

The Committee unanimously recommends,

1st That the plan for raising the roof about five feet over the Class 64 Room, thus forming a second floor over same, changes for kitchen accommodations, rest room, etc., be adopted in accordance with plans posted in the Chapel for two months or more.

2nd That the present pulpit platform be brought out about six feet and reconstructing or building a new baptistry so as to do away with the present rather unsightly pulpit platform arrangement, and provide permanent seats for the Chorus Choir.

3rd That if possible at this time provision be made for the building of a new chimney flue, to taken care of the new heating plant for the Church proper.

4th The Committee estimates the approximate cost of the alterations at between \$15,000.00 and \$17,000.00.

5th That the duly authorized Committee is to continue the work planned, and be given full power in conjunction with the official board of the Church, including Pastor, Deacons, Trustees and Finance Committee, to provide funds to complete the work, until such time as all contributions are available.

6th That the work be proceeded with as quickly as the necessary arrangements can be made (within the next few weeks) and complete same for the One Hundredth Anniversary Week.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the report be accepted and adopted as herein stated.
