STATEMENT OF FAITH OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD

The following are major doctrines of our fellowship. Please read them carefully. If you have any disagreement with or question about them, please be sure to ask the membership class teacher, a pastor, or one of the deacons.

We believe...

- the Bible is the inspired and only infallible and authoritative written Word of God
- there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit
- in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, in His personal future return to this earth in power and glory to rule a thousand years.
- in the blessed hope — the rapture of the Church at Christ's coming
- the only means of being cleansed from sin through repentance and faith in the precious blood of Christ.
- regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for personal salvation.
- in water baptism by immersion
- the redemptive work of Christ on the cross provides healing of the human body in answer to believing prayer
- the baptism in the Holy Spirit, according to Acts 2-4, is given to believers who ask for it
- in the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a holy life
- in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, the one to everlasting life and the other to everlasting damnation.

PLEASE GIVE A BRIEF TESTIMONY OF YOUR CONVERSION

I grew up in a Christian home where I prayed daily, regularly attended church, and loved God, but I didn't follow God fully out of my own love for Him until I was about 18 years old. At about 8 years old, I accepted Christ as my Savior. I especially loved an Assemblies of God church. Study and continued to struggle w/ answers to many questions. During college, God blessed me w/ friends & fellowship that helped me understand my relationship w/ Him.
