

Thoughts on the structure of the boards

Overview: The idea of one overarching board, called, for the sake or argument, Highway Ministries, with subsidiary boards makes most sense to me. Each board would be responsible for its own finances and administration, and each of the subsidiary boards would report up to the Highway Ministries Board. Each subsidiary boards would name its own representative to the Highway Ministries Board.

Highway Ministries Board:

I'd recommend that someone other than the pastor of one of the churches or the directors of one of the schools serve as chairman. Someone like Tom Rees or Joe Beretta would be good.

In addition to the representatives of the subsidiary boards and the officers that the Commonwealth requires for incorporation (secretary, treasurer?), the board would require counsel (someone like Chuck Draa). Other positions would be assigned at the pleasure of the chairman.

Highway Tabernacle Board:

I recommend that the board be constituted as it is currently but with the inclusion of the ministry team as non-voting members. One of the deacons would represent the board before the Highway Ministries board – this position could rotate.

Resurrection Life Board; SGA Board:
