Meeting held to affiliate 10/10/15 with 54 members.

Highway Tabernacle -- Philadelphia, Pennsylvania They were a church before the
turn of the century. We do not know when they became Pentecostal. They
affiliated 1-21-18 with their meeting and letter was issued 3-1-18

THE STONE CHURCH - Chicago, IL Affiliated 1941 Began as a church 12/9/06

Their records say they were a Pentecostal congregation in 1909
