SEMBLIES of God personnel in Pakistan has become greatly reduced with five missionaries returning home on furlough. Health reasons will keep three of them from coming back to Pakistan.

Moving to Khulna in the midst of riots, encountering the formidable problems of national unity, bidding farewell to faithful mission-aries and colleagues of many years, facing fierce opposition in open air meetings - these all have been a part of the drama of life, year 1964.
