
WE FOUND OUR PLACE

Yet we are not aiming for quantity only but quality in the type of young men that we train for God. For some years we have been unable to take in girl students because of dormitory facilities. This year God enabled us to purchase a new dormitory so that next year young ladies will again be able to train and take their place in the churches of India. We cannot doubt that we are in the centre of God's will for our lives.

Almost every student has a story to tell concerning his conversion. From the mountains of Nepal, from the jungles of Assam to the coconut plantations of Kerala, God has been faithful to call them into His ministry. What a privelege it is to have a share in shaping their lives. Pray for each one of them that they too may find their place in the vineyard of the Lord.
