


### GREATNESS AND GRACE IN INDIA


India is the largest peninsula in the world.  
 The heaviest rainfall in the world is at Cherrapunji—458 inches in a year.  
 India has the third highest dam in the world, 214 ft—Cauvery Mettur.  
 The largest dome in the World is the Gol Gumbaz 144 ft in diameter.  
 The longest railway platform in the world is at Sone—2,415 ft.  
 India is the richest country in the world in reserves of manganese and mica.  
 Every seventh person in the world is an Indian.  
 India has the largest irrigation works, and the largest mileage of canals,  
 She is the second largest producer of coal.  
 First paper mill was started by Dr. Wm. Carey. Now there are over 32.

There are over 8,000 foreign and national workers, in 388 missions.



In India there are over 6,000,000 Christians. There are 600,000 towns and villages and 25,000 Christian congregations, so that each congregation is responsible for sending the light to 24 villages or towns. There is one pastor to eight congregations.
