

## The Harold Schmitts Missionaries

They have left the Warren Assembly and are presently itinerating to go to Europe. Their home for the present will be at 3214 West Fardale Avenue, Apartment 3, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53221.

After over twenty years of pastoral ministry the Reverend Schmitt recently resigned as pastor of the First Assembly, Warren, Ohio, to accept missionary appointment to Germany. He will be the official representative of his denomination's Foreign Missions Department and will act in liaison and consultant capacities to the over 160 Pentecostal churches in that nation.

Previous to his last pastorate in Warren, where he ministered twenty-one months, Reverend Schmitt served pulpits in Jacksonville, Florida; Ravenna, Elyria and Eaton, Ohio. He also served as an assistant to the head-quarters church in Springfield, Missouri, and for a period of two years was Promotional Director of the Youth Department in the Assemblies of God.

Reverend Schmitt in a letter to the Office stated: "It was a real emotional upheaval for us to say good-bye to the Warren church. However the Lord has already indicated His pleasure in our obedience to His will by blessing in a very unusual way the missionary services we have conducted to date.
