Dear Friends,

As this issue of "Slavics for Christ" goes to press we are planning a trip to Europe to minister to our Slavic brethren over there. We already have our passport and have applied for visas for Poland and Yugoslavia, where limited ministry is permissible. We wish to have all those interested in souls to pray with us that we will be granted, not visitors visas but regular visas, as our purpose is not to go on a sight-seeing tour but on business for our King.

The influx of Russians into other open European countries has been tremendous and we have thousands to whom we can minister in France, Germany, Belgium, etc.

On this trip I shall be travelling alone, leaving my family behind in California. While in Europe, I shall explore the possibility of locating over there in the future. If this seems feasible, I shall move my family to Europe in a year or so, if the Lord so directs.

The bulk of our funds has not been coming in through pledged support. Thus far we have been able to maintain this radio work through the offerings of our missionary meetings held in various churches. We are not making this trip because of a great surplus in our account. On the contrary, we my not be able to go if funds do not come in for this purpose.

When I leave it will mean that I shall no longer be able to go to various churches to make appeals, therefore that supply line will be cut off. We dislike begging. In fact, we have never learned the art. Yet we feel that by making the need known, God's people will respond. Often we feel grieved to think that so little interest is shown in the Lord's work in comparison to the tremendous projects that the world engages in. Our civilization is making such rapid strides that the mere thought of it takes our breath away. How often we are stymied because our hands are tied with a total lack of funds. It is true that the Lord can and will provide, but He expects His people to shoulder the responsibility, as He only works through human media.

Our Assemblies of God has only two appointed missionaries to the Russian field, my wife and I. Elsewhere on this leaflet you will find a few comparisons made. Are you one of those who feels that a few bombs dropped on Russia will be far more effective? Or will you pray that sparks of Gospel Truth will fall on Russia by means of radio. Remember that a tiny spark can cause a great flame.
