according to the direction of the Sunday School Board. Reports of the operations of the Sunday School, both spiritual and financial, shall be made at periodic business meetings of the Church.

ARTICLE X Missionary Work

One subject of the institution of the Christian Church being the extension of the kingdom of Jesus Christ over the world, this Church is declared to be, in its entirety, a missionary organization, and all its members are expected, as God gives ability, to labor, pray and contribute for the spread of the Gospel both near and afar throughout the world. (*Matt.* 24:14; *Matt.* 28:19, 20)

ARTICLE XI

Committees

Standing Committees shall be appointed at or within thirty days after the annual business meeting of the Church, and shall serve until new committees are appointed.

Such Standing Committees as may be needed for the proper supervision of various lines of Christian Work in connection with the Church, not otherwise provided for, may be appointed by the Pastor and Board of Flders.

There shall be the following Committees:

1. Music Committee. The Music Committee shall consist of four members; the Pastor, the Chorister, the Music Director and a member of the Board of Elders, chosen annually by the Board of Elders.

It shall be the duty of the Music Committee to

secure suitable hymn books and instrumentalities, when required, to aid most effectively the service of song at the regular Gospel meetings of the Church and Work.

2. Open Air and Out-Station Committee. The Board of Elders, the Board of Deacons and Deaconesses and the Board of Trustees shall each elect one from their respective Boards to form, together with the Pastor and one member from the Church chosen by the Pastor, an Open Air and Out-Station Committee.

It shall be the duty of the Open Air and Out-Station Committee to arrange for the time and place of meetings, and to appoint qualified leaders who shall have charge of the conduct of services and selection of speakers.

The Young People's Organization may conduct their own street meetings, under the supervision of the Open Air and Out-Station Committee.

3. Nominating Committee. It shall be the duty of the Nominating Committee to select such persons from the Active Membership of the Church, who have received the Baptism in the Holy Ghost, as, in their judgment, are best fitted by their gifts, talents and life, to be nominees for the offices to be filled at the ensuing election, giving due consideration to new material, as well as incumbent officers.

A written report of such nominations, signed by at least a majority of the Committee, shall be submitted to the Church for ratification on the evening of the election, and such nominees shall be the candidates for the several offices designated, from which the required number shall be elected for each office by ballot.
