Following the election of officers, there was some discussion as to whether the ushers should have some part in sharing the expense for refreshments, etc., which in the past was borne by the host at whose home the ushers meeting was held. A suggestion was offered that the ushers contribute a sum of three dollars toward this expense. A motion was duly made by Howard Fern and seconded by Bro. McAnney that this sum be

made by Howard Fern and seconded by Bro. McAnney that this sum be taken out of the ushers treasury and given to the host for such a purpose. Unanimously carried.

The following names were officially voted on for membership to the association; Ernest Kallapathy and Arla Green. Bro. Howard Fern made a motion that they be accepted as members, seconded by Bob Lafferty. Carried.

The question of new members was brought up, and a committee was appointed by Bro. Benckert to interview any prospettive members,

with the following on the committee; Bob Lafferty and Howard Fern

When the question of new members was disposed of the meeting was thrown open for general discussion on how the ushers could render more effective service in their work for the church. Brother Steelburg was asked to say a few words and mong his suggestion he thought it might be a good plan if the ushers distributed greeting cards to visitors who came in. The question of badges again was brought up and it was decided that we consider using badges again, especially during special services.

Other matters dicussed was the need for a definite system of ushering, the necessity for ushers being on time, the necessity of ushers taking care of newcomers by showing them to their seats, etc., etc. As for a dfinite plan in ushering, Bro. Benckert stated he had one in mind, which he expected to bring into operation short!

As there was no further business the many adjourned with a closing word of prayer.
