

April 27, 1954

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was called on Tuesday April 27, 1954 with the following members present, Bre. George Ambrose, Bre. Allen Dren, Bre. Thomas Griffith, Bre. Walter McAnney, Bre. Oscar Schmeal, Bre. Chas MacPherson and Pastor Wallace Bragg, Bre. Elmer Day being absent.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Bre. Allen Dren, the minutes of the previous meeting was read by Bre. Chas MacPherson and after a slight correction they were accepted as read.

The matter of full support for our Sis. Ros Reineker who is a missionary to India came up for discussion. A motion was made by Bre. Chas. MacPherson, and seconded by Bre. Allen Dren that we take her on full time which would be around \$80.00 a month.

Bre. Oscar Schmeal made a motion and it was seconded by Bre. Allen Dren that we send the same amount of money to Italy that we gave to the Perna's for support. Money to be sent to Bre. Gereatti in Italy to be used for one or two missionaries as he sees fit, and as far as money will go in supporting these brethren in Italy.

Bre. George Ambrose made a motion and it was seconded by Bre. Walter McAnney that we have all the painting done at the Parnage as of according to estimate work to be done at one by Beardsley the painter.

Bre. Ambrose made a motion it was seconded by Oscar Schmeal that we send a check for \$100.00 to Fayetteville, North Carolina for Servicemens work. It is a Pentecostal work.

A motion was made by Bre. MacPherson and seconded by Bre. McAnney that we give \$50.00 toward a station wagon for the work in the Phillipines in Manila. Money to be sent to Glen Herst who is sec'y of promotions for the work.

A motion was made by Bro. Schmeal and seconded by Allen Dren that in the event Highway gets new song books as was discussed, that we pick out the best ones in the church and send them to Bro. Cyril Huckerly at Kingston Jamaica who is in need of song books.

The question of the property on Crease Street which is a mission and is for sale came up, and after a lengthy discussion it was decided that Pastor Bragg bring a report to the quarterly business meeting on May the 17, the Board of Trustees looked at the property and it was nice as far as the Board was concerned. But the big problem would be how to purchase the said property and to point out the pros and cons of the mission on Crease St. Also to let the congregation decide what to do in said matter.

A request by Barbara Bragg to practice on the organ at 6:00 P.M. on Sunday nights was turned down by the Board of Trustees, as they along with the music director feel that no one should practice on Sundays. Bro. Griffith to ask her to try and pick another time suitable.

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees was called on Sunday May 30, 1954 to decide what to give Bro. Garfield in the way of financial help, as he is starting a Jewish work work in Phila. Springfield could only give him the sum of \$75.00 a quarter. The Board of Trustees decided to give him \$325.00 a quarter with \$175.00 to be taken from the missionary fund and \$150.00 a quarter to be taken from the Revival Time Program. Making a total of \$400.00 a quarter. Money is to be sent through Springfield for his support.

It was brought to the Board of Trustees attention that two members of Highway's Young People who graduated from C.B.I. in 1954 who's names or pictures were not in the year book. Alex Hunter and Melvin Waggoner. The Board of Trustees were very put out about it and all members present voted that we should contact Springfield and find out why, as we get the year book for our library every year.
