is in need of song books.

The Board of Trustees decided to give him \$325.00 a quarter with \$175.00 to be taken from the missionary fund and \$150.00 a quarter to be taken from the Revival Time Program. Making a total of \$400.00 a quarter. Money is to be sent through Springfield for his support.
