Bro. Elmer Day our treasurer could not attend but sent in

a report of the finances. The report was read by Bro. Thes.

Griffith and were accepted as read.

The Beard of Trustees veted to send our missionaries a Christmas gift of \$25.00 to those who are single and \$50.00 to married couples, checks to be sent out at once.

The Board of trustees decided to take a special offering on Sunday January 16, 1954 to be given to Paster Bragg as a farewell effering to him. Board was also told that the Paster's furniture was to be moved out on the 14th day of January. Paster's last service was to be held on sunday morning January 16, 1954 - Bro. McDowell to take evening service.

Bre. Oscar Schmeil gave a report as chairman of the house committee, also told of painting to be done in beginners department, and also the old Crusaders room. Bre. Schmeil said he would like to try and get work done by organizing a volunteer crew to come down and do the work.

Board of Trustees voted to give sexten \$10.00 a menth as personal expense money so as to help defray expenses for extra trips he makes to church and back, also pay's carfare for wife twice a week as she helps him with the work.

Board of Trustees also looked into the matter of the women's toilet on the first floor in back of Sunday School room.
