A meeting of The Board of Trustees was held October 30,1956 at Bro. Schmiel's home.

Those that were present were Bros: Roberson, McPherson, Day, Griffith, Schmiel, Ambrose, Dron.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Bro. Roberson.

Bro. Roberson made a report as to Revival Time. He said that he wrote to Epringfield for a quarterly report on Highway's giving. Their report was that the average was 140 to 170 a month, or about \$450 a quarter. It is evident that the giving direct has a decided effect in the report by our Treasurer on the receipts for Missions.

Bro. Schmiel made a report on the nursery. The partition has been completed and that the floor is to be laid and the mursery is to be painted.

It was suggested that Sister Alexander be contacted in reference to the locking of the doors in the basement because of being a fire hazard. This was turned over to the House Committee to make a survey of the situation.

It was suggested that we ask the Missionary Council to make covers for the chairs in the ladies room. Bro. Roberson said that he would present this request to Mrs. Roberson, as she is head of the Council.

It was moved and seconded that we pay for the material to be used by the Council in making the covering for the chairs.

A report was made on the work of the renovating of the Church building. The circle is to re replaced by cinder blocks and to be blended with the other stone work. Also that the cellar windows on the 19th Street side be blocked up.

It was suggested that we have Bro. Paul Ortlip do and inside carpentry work that is need.

It was suggested that we ask the Contractor if he would remove the junk in have in the cellar at the time that he is carrying his junk away.

A complaint was received that the relay for the chimes on the organ were not working properly. This has since been corrected. The Organ Compay is to let us know what can be done in reference to the wiring that is around the organ. These wires should be enclosed in a casing.

Bro. Roberson said that the Greek Brother had called and thanked us but declined to accept our offer for the use of the Church Building for his meetings.

It was moved and seconded that we make available to the Choir the sum of not move than \$200 a year.

The Orland Church has requested that they would like to have some of our discarded songbooks. It was therefore, moved and seconded that we give to them 100 books, also that we give Bro. Garrist d some of the books that we have left for his work.

The meeting was closed with prayer.
