

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was held, Tuesday, November 18, 1957 in the Church.

Those present were Bros. Roberson, Ambrose, Schmiel, Griffith, Simokat and Dron.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Bro. Dron.

The minutes of the last meeting was read and after a correction made was accepted.

The selling of the old parsonage by auction was discussed. It was decided that we still leave the selling in the hands of a Realtor. Our present Realtor assured us that he will do his best and is to advertise in the paper.

The House Committee reported progress. The pianos have been tuned, but the tuning of the organ has not yet been done, as there was no key for the organ. The paint work on the inside of the Church has not be started. A discussion on the possibility of cancelling the contract with Beardsley and to have the men of the Church do the work was held. A motion which was seconded was made that inquiry into the cost for the men doing the work be made, then the contractor be notified if we feel that doing the work ourselves would be to our advantage.

The bill which Bro. Ambrose presented at the last meeting was again tabled until the next meeting.

Bro. Ambrose explained to us about the placing of racks which could be placed in the pews for the holding of envelopes. He was asked to bring in a sample also to give the cost for the making and installing of them. A suggestion was made that the House Committed have clothes hooks put up on the walls in the Nursery. Bro. Ambrose said that he would make a wooden rack to hold the hooks.

Authorization was made that the Treasurer pay the bill for the patching of the roof.

The chairs and couch which Bro. Seery brought be returned as we feel that they are not needed.

A motion was made by Bro. Simokat, but was not seconded. The motion was that we purchase the typewriter for Sister Alta. from Bro. Seery for \$90.

Bro. Schmiel asked that the Financial Committee look into the possibility of salary increases to take care of the raise in the cost of living. A report by this Committee to be presented at the next meeting.
