

March 13th, 1960

Board of Trustees Meeting held on March 13th, 1960, was attended by all members - with the pastor Bro. Roberson also present.

The meeting opened with a word of prayer by Bro. Roberson - following which the Secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting and the Treasurer gave his report on the status of the church exchequer.

Bro. Roberson reported a need presented by Springfield, regarding an emergency which arose in connection with the work in Manila-Phillipine field, where it was necessary to bring back Bro. Cawston to this field to cope with this emergency. Support was asked for Bro. Cawston, and the Board moved and seconded that we contribute \$25 per month toward this support - or \$75 per quarter of 3 months.

It was brought to the attention of the Board that Bro. Hunt was experiencing considerable difficulty for support in his pioneer work among the Indians in North Carolina. Before any action to ease this situation could be taken, the Board felt further inquiry should be made regarding this need, and Bro. Roberson was delegated to get all the particulars in this particular case and report to the Board his findings.

Bro. Roberson mentioned that the pastor and officers of the Colored Baptist Church at 22nd & Jefferson St. showed considerable interest in the purchase of our church at 19th & Green, and that they were making the necessary arrangements with Greenfield the real estate agent to negotiate for the sale of their church at 22nd & Jefferson. Outside of that nothing further was reported.
