

April 17, 1961

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, held on April 17th, the following members were present; Griffith, Dron, Schmiel, Ambrose, Heintz, Simokat and Brother Roberson;

The Trustee Board met for a few moments with Bro. Elmer Day and Michael Kessick, representing the Highway Home for the Aged to consider some plan for keeping records of money turned in at the church earmarked for the Highway Home for the Aged. After some discussion the brethren felt they were not prepared to come up at this time with any definite plan for keeping such records, with the matter to be left in abeyance for future consideration.

Following this discussion entered into their regular meeting with the reading by the secretary of the minutes of the previous meeting - followed by reading <sup>of</sup> the Treasurers report by Bro. Dron. Both reports accepted as read.

On motion made by Bro. Dron - seconded by Bro. Schmiel the House Committee was authorized to go ahead with any necessary cement work in front of the church, as well as take any necessary steps for planting of shrubbery on the ground plots front and side of church. \$700 was allocated for this double project. Also on work to be done voluntary help was to be solicited.

In view of the fact that nothing was heard from the owner of the lot at 19th & Spring Garden for reduction of rental fee, the Secretary was delegated to notify Mr. Lavine that our monthly rental contract was to terminate with the payment of the rent for the month of May.



On motion made by Bro. Dron, seconded by Bro. Schmiehl  
the Board agreed to go ahead with the purchase of material  
for the Public Address System. Several members of the church  
to do the work of installation of this PA system.
