

May 15th, 1961

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held on May 15th, the following members were present; Griffith, Dron, Schmiel, Ambrose, Heintz, Simokat and the pastor, Brother Roberson.

Brother Schmiel opened the meeting with a word of prayer, followed by the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, and the Treasurers report.. Both reports accepted as read.

On motion made by Bro. Dron, and seconded by Bro Heintz, the Secretary was requested to write a letter to Evangel College, authorizing them to appropriate one hundred dollars to Bro. Jack Day, out of the existing Scholarship Fund in that college, on condition that he enters Evangel College for the 1961-1962 school year. However, in the event that Bro. Day does not complete the full term for that year, any money for the unfinished part of the year is to be returned to the Evangel Scholarship Fund. Duly carried.

It was also moved by Bro. Dron, and seconded by Bro. Simokat that on future scholarship grants to Evangel College, the amount is not to exceed \$100.00 for any student entering Evangel for the period of one year.

On motion made by Bro. Dron, seconded by Bro. Griffith, the Board agreed to increase the money allocated for the church landscaping-cementing project to \$900 - or an additional \$200.

It was duly moved and seconded to authorize the Treasurer make a payment of \$350.00 to Mr English for plumbing work work in the church; also \$2000 to Mr. Frank Davis to reduce the balance of indebtedness down to \$10,000.
