

Brother Roberson read a letter from Mr. Sherman of the Christian Mutual Life Insurance Co. regarding their proposition for a loan of \$45,000 payable over a period of 25 years - on the basis of \$ 290 per month. It was suggested that before committing ourselves we first go over this plan with Mr. Zoegler our attorney.






November 12th, 1961


