A motion was made by Pastor Roberson and seconded by Bro. Heint that we cancel the contract on the Pipe Organ as it is very rarely played, and the Board felt it is a waste of money. Which is \$100.00 dollars a year for servicing it. Bro. MacPherson to get a letter off to Mr. Boyer.

The matter of air conditioners came up and the rooms were visit by members of the Board. The members of the Board felt one should go into Sister Wallen's room and a bigger one in the auditorium on the second floor of the Sunday School. Pastor

Roberson made a motion seconded by Bro. George Ambrose that we get an estimate at once and report back to the Board. Motion was carried. Pastor Roberson then brought before the Board the matter of papering and painting of the Parsonage inside. Bathroom paper is dirty, center arch and hallway paper dirty.
