

Monday October 25, 1965

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday October 25, 1965 with the following members present, Pastor Roberson, Thomas Griffith, Allen Dron, Oscar Schmiel, Chas. MacPherson and George Griffin. Fred Heintz and George Ambrose were absent. The meeting was opened with Bro. Dron reading from the Bible. Thomas Griffith then lead us in prayer for the requests that were mentioned and for God's Blessing on the meeting.

Bro. Schmiel then introduced a Mr. Kelly and our Bro. Elmer Katz who are insurance agents for the Preferred Risk Insurance Co. They are at this time helping to write up a new policy for the church and Parsonage, and to explain and answer all questions that might arise. After a lengthy discussion it was decided to take action on a new policy at a later date.

Bro. MacPherson then read the minutes of the previous meeting and they were accepted as read. Bro. Dron gave us the report of the finances of the church and they were accepted as read.

Bro. George Griffin then gave us the report of the House Committee and read two estimates from Paul Ortlip as to the work that had to be done at the Parsonage, such as repair front porch beam, replace shingles, repair patio roof, chimney coping and etc. One price was \$430.00 dollars and the other was \$725.00 dollars to build an A type roof to be tied in with other existing roof. Motion was made by Bro. Dron and seconded by Bro. George Griffin to have the work done at the price of \$430.00 dollars.

Bro. George Griffin then mentioned about lighting that could be had by the Phila. Electric Co. for lighting the outside of the church. Bro. Griffin said they also would maintain and take care of the poles. Bro. Thomas Griffith was to look into the matter and to report back to the Board.

Pastor Roberson brought to the Boards attention about Bob Bartlett of Teen Challenge that their auto insurance had run out and they were given a weeks grace. Bro. Dron made a motion and seconded by Bro. Thomas Griffith that we send them a donation of \$100.00 dollars toward the insurance.

Bro. Schmiel brought up the matter about having some one go over the church records that were in the basement, and to see which we should keep or dispose of. Also to have the fire extinguishers filled and rearranged in the church.

Pastor Roberson then brought up about the special meetings for the Missionary Convention at Thanksgiving time. He suggested that we give Bro. Hurst \$100.00 dollars for speaking. Bro. Long \$100.00 dollars for three services and Bro. Bowman \$200.00 dollars who will be speaking eight times during the services. Bro. Bowman to stay at the Parsonage.

A motion was made to adjourn. Pastor Roberson then closed the meeting with prayer.
