

Monday October 17, 1966

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Monday October 17, 1966 with the following members present, Pastor Roberson, Bros. Thos. Griffith, MacPherson, Ambrose and Allen Dron, Heintz and Gerhart were absent.

The meeting was opened with Bro. Thos. Griffith reading from the Bible the 1st Psalm. Bro. MacPherson then led us to the Throne of Grace for Gods Blessing on the meeting and those who are sick in our midst. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Bro. MacPherson and were accepted as read.

The report of the Treasurer was read by Bro. Dron and was accepted as read with a vote of thanks to our Bro.

A motion was made by Bro. Griffith and seconded by Bro. Dron that we purchase one dozen pins to be worn by the ushers at the cost not to exceed \$1.50 a piece. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Bro. Thos. Griffith and seconded by Bro. Dron that we purchase ten flourescent lights, two for the Baptismal room, two for Sister Krauses class, five for Sister Roberson's class and one to be used in the hall. Cost to be around \$260.00 dollars. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Pastor Roberson and seconded by Thos. Griffith that we send out of the Scholarship fund \$75.00 dollars to David Dron at C.B.I., \$75.00 dollars to David Rines at N.B.I. and also \$75.00 dollars to Howard Valentine at N.B.I. for this semester.

A motion was made by Bro. MacPherson and seconded by Pastor Roberson that we incease our Missionary giving to Teen Challenge from \$60.00 dollars a month to \$100.00 dollars a month, and to pay a \$300.00 dollars oil bill which they owe. As they are in financial difficulty at this time.

A motion was made by Thos. Griffith and seconded by Bro. MacPherson that we purchase five hundred calenders at ~~seventeen~~<sup>30¢</sup> cents apiece to be given to the church congregation at the Christmas season. Pastor Roberson to take care of the matter as he has the literature on this.

A motion to adjourn was made by Bro. Dron. Pastor Roberson closed the meeting with prayer.
