

Tuesday September 9, 1967

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Tuesday September 9, 1967 with all members present except Bro. Chas. MacPherson.

Bro. Roberson opened the meeting with the reading of the scriptures from God's Word.

No minutes were read as Bro. MacPherson was absent.

The Treasurers report was read and he was given a vote of thanks for his fine work as Treasurer.

House Committee had no report to make at this time.

\$75.00 dollars each were sent from the Scholarship fund money to David Rines, Harry Valentine, Howard Valentine and David Dron.

Bro. Modder was dropped from Missionary support by instructions from Missionary Field. Bro. Roberson recommended to keep sending Modders money to India marked Greenaway. Accepted as recommended.

Bro. Ambrose recommended that we authorize the Pastor to buy calenders for the church at Christmas time. Accepted as recommended.

Bro. Griffith informed the Board that the Pastors lawn should be cut by hired help. Accepted as recommended.

A review of salaries was discussed. Study will be made by Finance Committee and report back to Board.
