

Trustee Meeting February 6, 1968

The meeting opened with Bible reading and prayer.

The previous Secretary's minutes were read by Dom Mariano and they were accepted as read.

The Treasurer's report was read by Allen Dron. Deficit spending was pointed out by the Pastor and the treasurer. No action was recommended and the report was accepted as read.

Election of new trustee officers was conducted by the Pastor. The following officers were elected:

Assistant Treasurer - John Gerheart

The House Committee was chosen - Dick Ambrose, was named Chairman, Fred Heintz and Al Luff were named co-workers.

The new president urged all trustees to check in at the office before going into the service.

The Pastor read a letter from Wesley Hurst, Home Secretary, asking for help to a most urgent need. The Secretary requested support for a Joseph Roma, for \$25.00 a month, to send him to Melbourn, Australia to work among the Italian section. After a brief discussion Bro. Heintz moved to accept the request. ~~Dom~~ second the move. The motion was passed.

The Pastor suggested to pass cards out for people to give over and beyond their tithes and offering - no action was taken.

The Pastor advised us of sending twelve folding chairs to Dorothy Grossglass at the Northampton Church - the move was concurred by the board.

The House Committee chairman Dick Ambrose varified that all flooring is of substantial strength to support the organ.

Brother Roberson reported that the paint job of a year and a half ago at the parsonage was worn and peeling. He suggested that a new paint job was in order. A motion was made by Bro. Dron that the House Committee investigate and take the necessary steps. The motion was seconded by Bro. Luff and the motion was passed as moved.

Metal railing was discussed - no action taken.

Al Luff suggested that the membership should be told of the gift to the students. He felt that good will would be created. The public relations officer (Bro. Roberson) was unanimously elected for the job.

All missionary funds were discussed by Bro Dron. He felt that the Sunday School was not funneling the missionary money properly through the church treasury. After a healthy round of talks, no action was taken.

Brother Heintz moved that the meeting adjourn. Br. Dron second - the motion carried.

Refreshments were donated by Al Luff with the skillful maneuvering of Leon. A hearty thank was extended by all.
