

*Trustee Meeting September 30, 1968*

*Meeting was opened with Bible reading and prayer.*

*The Secretary read the minutes and they were accepted as read.*

*The Treasurer read his report and they were accepted as read.*

*No report from the house committee.*

*Brother Dron reported for the Pastor as follows:*

- 1. Recommended that we give the following people \$75.00 each to help pay their school tuition - Harry and Howard Valentine, Renny Wallen, and Dave Dron. Recommendation unanimously accepted and moved for action.*
- 2. Radio contract is under advisement -no final action at this time.*
- \* 3. Recommended a counter top for the Sunday School room. The recommendation was not clear on the need of a counter top was not clear. It was suggested that the house committee look into the matter.*
- 4. Reported that the desk for Rev. Chadwich cost \$137.25.*

*Dom Mariano discussed selling Sears stock. After very much discussion President Griffith moved that the treasurer make a survey of the stock situation and report back at the next meeting. It was seconded by Fred Heintz and moved.*

*Dom Mariano read the Royal Ranger report that was submitted by Dick Ambrose. It was accepted as read.*

There was an open discussion on dropping the Bulletin ad in favor of the radio - no action taken.

Treasurer Dron moved that we authorize the purchase of calanders for the coming Christmas season - all concurred.

The installation of the outside fence was discussed - Brother Heintz was asked to look in to the matter.

Bro. Griffith discussed the possibilities of renting a bus for the Sunday School. He explained the situation surrounding the Catholic priest and the probability of getting fifty people from one area. The Committee granted the use of the bus for a one month trial.

It was recommended that shelves be built between the Sunday School room and the Trustee room - all concurred.

Brother Dron moved to adjourn, Heintz seconded - we closed with prayer.
